

COVENANT

TO BE APPLIED TO THE TRANSFER OF BLAGROVE WOOD BRATTON CLOVELLY OKEHAMPTON DEVON

The Covenant is designed to ensure the owner and subsequent owners do not use the wood for anything which would be a nuisance to neighbouring woodland owners. It also prevents subsequent division of the ownership of the wood into smaller units.

Wording of the Covenant (or "legal promise") for the transfer:-

The purchaser hereby covenants with the vendor for himself and for his successors in title not to use suffer or permit to be used at the Property hereby transferred or any part of the same for any of the following:-

1. Clay pigeon shooting or use of guns (apart from air powered weapons) for target practise or any kind.
2. Rough shooting or pest control at such times or in such manner as to be or become a danger or nuisance or annoyance to any person.
3. Racing or speed trials with cycles or any motorised vehicle.
4. A commercial campsite.
5. Business purposes other than that of agriculture or forestry.
6. Any use that causes or is likely to cause damage to access tracks on the Retained Land other than fair wear and tear.
7. Any use that would be or become a nuisance or annoyance to neighbouring owners or occupiers of land including the Transferor.
8. The installation or display of any signboard that is or may become visible from the public highway.

And the property hereby transferred shall not be sold leased or otherwise disposed of except in whole as opposed to in part.
